

Asa Payne Cottage

Originally built in 1959, Asa Payne was the first permanent cottage at Rock Springs. It was a gift from the Garvey Foundation of Wichita. The cottage was remodeled in 2010 and is now part of our Rim Rock housing. Co-Op and Weatherwax Cottages are also included.

Asa Payne is available year-round and hosts 25 persons at full capacity. This popular residence is composed of seven separate sleeping rooms; room number one is a handicap accessible suite, including a private, accessible restroom. Rooms two through seven each hold two sets of bunk beds, and provide ample room for storing luggage. Guests have access to two large restrooms which are centrally located. A stylish lobby area with comfortable seating, as well as a fireplace, make Asa Payne a popular choice for fall and winter getaways. The kitchenette, equipped with microwave and small refrigerator, adds to the modern appeal.
