Fun facts about Rock Springs



- Rock Springs was established in 1946 and has been operated by the Kansas 4-H Foundation since then.
- A stone wall from an original cabin built in 1857 still stands near the craft center.
- A natural spring supplies all of Rock Springs 4-H Center's water resources and has never been known to fail!
- The spring supplies 1,000 gallons of water per minute and the average temperature is 54° Fahrenheit.
- Rock Springs is a year-round facility that hosts over 20,000 visitors annually for camps, retreats, conferences, weddings, and family reunions.
- Rock Springs & Camp WaShunGa can house nearly 900 people at full capacity.
